"Revival of Grace"

How we have allowed others to rob us of the beauty of grace.

John 1:14

"In the beginning..." was Jesus, and grace. Would people call me a "grace filled" person?

God's grace is past, present and future. Upon which aspect of God's grace do I focus? Do I forget? Do I ignore?

Read John 1:14 again. Sit for a few minutes in silence and ponder the depth of the verse. Does God's grace dwell in and around me? How can I tell?

Read Ephesians 2:8,9- How do I try and bargain for God's grace in my life? If I believe I do not earn grace, how do I try to get others to earn my grace for them?

Colossians 3:5-10 Paul tells us how to live by grace. Which thing in Paul's list is the easiest for me to do? The hardest? The one I ignore most?

How has God's grace changes how I live? Speak? Act? Can you name an example?

God's grace is future. "You have a blood bought, absolutely certain, inexpressibly happy, totally undeserved future with God" (John Piper). If I believe this statement, how is it reflected in my life right now?

What will I do to have a "Revival of Grace" in my life, and provide one for someone else?
