

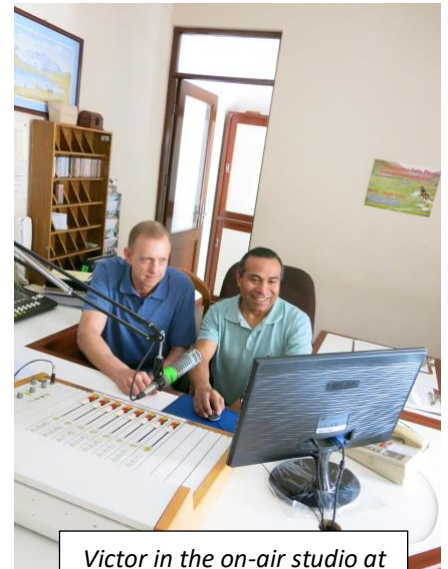
Bentleys' Prayer Corner – June '24

I was just now communicating via WhatsApp with Victor Campos, who was the Director of the Quechua Radio station and ministries for 15 years. Lucinda and I got to know Victor when living in Sucre for our first 10 years in Bolivia. Later Victor and I shared side-by-side offices at the radio station during his years in Cochabamba. He recently did me the favor of writing an article for the Evangelical Missions Quarterly on the progress of the Gospel among the Quechua over the past decades and the continuing needs in the present context of the church in Bolivia. If you're interested you can find the article Victor authored on the Amazon Kindle site. It's in the "EMQ April-June 2024: Evangelical Missions Quarterly – Volume 60 Issue 2" (*the article entitled "God's grace abounds among the Quechua"*). It gives an excellent summary of the progress of the Gospel among the Quechuas, the impact of Quechua radio Mosoj Chaski, and the need that exists presently. Unfortunately, the Quarterly is not free.

Pray for Victor and his wife, Ofelia, who also worked for many years at Mosoj Chaski. They now live in Sucre, where Victor is from originally. They're teaching youth and providing leadership in the local church Lucinda and I were involved in during the mid-1980's. Victor also helps with Mosoj Chaski's mobile Quechua Bible training, and with Langham Partners. Both Victor and Ofelia have their hand in multiple ministry "pies", and continue to be used of God in impactful ways in his kingdom.
